

Dear Parents and Carers,

Today we said good bye to our year 6 pupils with a very different leavers' assembly on the playground. We send them on their way with all our best wishes as they embark on the next stage of their education.

Over the next 3 weeks until the end of term, we will be welcoming groups of children from Classes 2, 3, 4 and 5 for their day in school. All of these groups will be coming into school through the Class 6 entrance.

School arrival time for these groups will be 9.00 – 9.10 am and pick up time will be 3.00pm. During drop off and pick up times, only one parent should come to school and social distancing measures should be followed. In the morning, children will be met at the main school gate by school staff so that adults do not need to come into the playground. Hand sanitiser will be used at this point.

At the end of the school day, one parent per family can come onto the school playground and the children will be brought out. Please spread out over the playground adopting appropriate social distancing away from the gate so that it is easier for people to leave. We ask that any children brought on to the playground stay with their adult.

Children will need to bring a carrier bag with them on the day so that they can bring all their books home. They will also need their water bottle, a packed lunch and healthy snack. We would also like them to bring back any library books which they can drop into a box in the classroom. **No fabric lunchboxes or book bags should be brought into school.** As I am sure many children will have grown out of their school uniform, they can dress in their normal clothes for the day.

The arrangements for Reception, Class 1 and key worker groups remain the same until the end of term.

Teachers will provide learning on Seesaw for the last time on week beginning Monday 6th July. End of year reports will be sent out electronically on Friday 10th July.

Your child's new teacher will be sending out a short presentation at the end of term which you can watch with them to prepare for September.
