Treasurers Report:

The committee's aim to surpass the £12,000 raised in the previous academic year was of course hugely affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. Despite this, the committee got off to a flying start and raised over £6000, most of this in the first term. A large chunk of this was by way of match funding received from Barclaycard following the Christmas Fayre. The committee continue to be grateful for the support received by Barclaycard and this year in particular it has made a real difference.

In July 2020 we donated £6000 to the school, which has been used to purchase new iPads for the children.
